To Whom it may Concern:

Linn County, through its Road and Bridge Department, will provide dust abatement for county residents who make application for such measures. Linn County will offer Magnesium Chloride this year at a rate of \$1.693 per foot, with a 200-foot minimum order (**\$338.60 minimum charge**). **All applications must include payment!**

Please be advised that this product does not control dust 100 percent. This dust abatement material is affected by weather and traffic, which realistically limits its effectiveness to the summer months. Linn County cannot guarantee the life expectancy of the dust control applied to any given area. Variables affecting the effectiveness and duration of treatment include traffic, thickness of gravel, drainage, etc.

The program will begin on or about April 29th, 2019 and will continue through completion. **Applications must be received in this office by April 15th, 2019 with full payment included to be eligible.** We will make every effort to have your road in the best shape possible prior to applying the magnesium chloride treatment. However, we must inform you that if the road gets too rough, we will maintain it as necessary after treatment.

To request magnesium chloride, please complete the enclosed application and return it to the address above by April 15th, 2019. Please mark the area that you wish to have treated with flags so that the area may be prepared before application. (Flags are available for pick-up at the Courthouse Annex, 306 Main Street, Mound City, if needed.) A statement will be mailed after dust control has been applied.
