Filing Your Personal Property

File Your Personal Property:

Kansas law (K.S.A. 79-306) states that every person who owns or holds tangible personal property subject to taxation must list that property with the County Appraiser of the county where such property is located on January 1st.

To avoid filing penalties, the Property Worksheet (Rendition) should be returned to the Linn County Appraiser's Office no later than March 15th each year. Penalties for failure to file will accrue 5% monthly up to 50%. These filing penalties can greatly affect your tax bill in November.
