

Notice to Boat Owners

Per Kansas law, the County Appraiser does not have statutory authority to prorate the value of a watercraft when the owner fails to notify the county of its sale within the statutory timeframe, which is on or before December 20th in the year of the sale.

If no notice or bill of sale is received, then the watercraft will remain on the tax roll at its full market value for that tax year.
